INTRODUCTION

Established in 2010 by the Ontario Conference Pathfinder Council (OCPC), the Pathfinder Academic Scholarship is awarded for the overall development of pathfinders in the pursuit of academic excellence.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist pathfinders to achieve their educational goals by providing financial aid to full-time, post-secondary studies.

ELIGIBILITY

The Applicant:

- Must be a pathfinder who is currently involved in a local Pathfinder Club
- Must have maintained a minimum B+ (80%) average in high school, grades 11 and 12; OR a CGPA of at least 2.67 (B-) if applying after first year of College or University. Transcripts must be provided
- Does not have to show financial need to qualify
- Can apply to a public or an Adventist institution within North America
- Must be a Canadian Citizen, or legal resident
- May reapply however, persons who reapply will be considered only after eligible first time applicants.
 Award will be granted for a maximum of 2 years, with satisfactory GPA

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed Application form

2. Three letters of reference:

- From a School Official Outlining involvement in
- School and contribution to school dynamics
- From Community Agency (outside of Pathfinder Ministry) outlining community involvement and statement of impact
- From your Pathfinder Director

3. Personal statement, to include:

- General Background information
- Demonstrated timeliness in completing tasks
- Problem Solving Ability
- Organizational skills
- Career Objectives
- A Short essay (200 500 words) explaining why you should be chosen for the award.
- Transcript including course information

SUBMISSION:

Application forms are available through the Education and Youth Ministries department of the Ontario Conference (OC), in local churches, or at www.ontariopathfinders.ca

Application must be completed in its entirety, must be legible, presented in a manner that is reflective of a University/College student and submitted to the OC no **later than June 30**.

SELECTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

In addition to the Application Information, the applicant will also be scored on the following:

- Demonstrated Leadership ability
- Concern for others
- Active involvement in Pathfindering
- Completion of the Master Guide course, or in the process of doing so (MGT)

To qualify, the applicant must achieve an average score of 80.

GRANTING OF AWARDS

At least one award will be given annually to qualified applicants. Dollar amount per award and number of awards will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and based on the availability of funds. All awards will be paid directly to the enrolled recipient's academic institution on his/her behalf.
