PURCHASE OF TICKETS

The registration process for **North American Division (NAD) Clubs** is on a first-come-first-serve basis, meaning that registration is open while tickets last. So don't wait for the last minute, **please purchase your tickets ASAP!**

Only one account may be created for each church with the club director as the one authorize to register his/her club members. If your church has created more than one account, please **contact CYE** with the account information of those multiple accounts and clarify which account should be the main account.

DAY PASSES

If you live in the United States or Canada, you may purchase single day passes through your club account to ensure that each day pass holder is approved by the club director and has a background check. Guests who have purchased Day Passes must find accommodations outside of the Camporee grounds; no overnight camping will be permitted. A limited number of Day Passes will go on sale beginning April 1, 2024.

Single Day Pass: **US\$ 75**

LOCAL REGISTRATION

1. **Yearly Club Registration** – All Pathfinder clubs should be registered with the Ontario Conference by **January 31, 2024** with a minimal fee of **\$35** (\$45 after Jan. 31st) and payment of **\$4.50/person** for accident insurance coverage. ***

*** Includes a maximum of \$ 5 million medical coverage with AD & D (\$50,000), Accidental Para- Medical Expense Reimbursement (\$50,000) and dental (\$2,500). Those with pre-existing health conditions should get their own medical insurance in addition to this accident insurance. **All Pathfinders, staff, parents, non-Pathfinder siblings, and volunteers who will attend the BTP**

Camporee in August 2024 should be included in the yearly club registration by January 30, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Also, as a requirement to complete your club registration, all staff members should have done their Vulnerable Sector Check. Remember, these are all important prerequisites for your club to be allowed to join the Ontario Conference at the Believe the Promise (BTP) camporee.

2. Local Registration for Bus Transportation and Campsite Allocation –

All clubs planning to go to Gillette, WY are expected to register with the Ontario Conference for bus reservation, campsite allocation, and other administrative purposes. A different fee will apply for those who will drive on their own. Remember, only those clubs that will complete this Local Conference Registration form will be eligible for space allotment at the BTP camporee. Online registration will be available starting January 3, 2024.

Note: Total number of people to be registered with the Ontario Conference should correspond with the number of tickets purchased by your club as shown on the BTP website:

Local Registration Cost and Deadline (March 31, 2024)

- **Regular Registration and Bus Reservation**
= \$ 750.00 CAD/person
(Amount is inclusive of roundtrip bus transportation, administrative services, Ontario pin and t-shirt.)
- **Local Registration for those travelling on their own:**
= \$ 50.00 CAD/person
(Amount is inclusive of roundtrip bus transportation, administrative services, Ontario pin and t-shirt.)

The Ontario Conference has reserved fifteen 56-seater coach buses to transport people to and from Gillette, WY. Clubs are encouraged to observe the abovementioned deadline to facilitate planning for bus transportation arrangements, campground allotment, ordering of camporee shirts and pins, etc. Thanks for registering promptly.

- **Truck Transportation**
= \$ 30.00 CAD/person
(Amount is inclusive of roundtrip shipment of camping gears and equipment)

The Ontario Conference plans to rent three tractor-trailers to transport camping equipment to and from Gillette, WY. All interested clubs are encouraged to register and pay the applicable fees. More instructions regarding this matter will be announced soon.

NOTE: Fees above are for your reference and for planning purposes; they are subject to change based on the final quote that the bus or truck company will provide.

PIN DESIGN CONTEST

The Ontario Conference Pathfinder Council and the Pathfinder Advisory of the Seventh-day Adventist Church in Canada (SDACC) are looking for creative individuals who can come up with designs for lapel pins to be used for pin trading at the BTP Camporee in 2024.

General Rules:

- Design should be made in vector format. Submission should have the design presented with 2 different dimensions: 8.5"x11" and 1.5"x1.5" (as this may be the actual size of the lapel pin)
- A maximum of 5 colours shall be allowed. Do not count the colour of the metal pin material as it will appear at the edge of the design. If black and white are used, they are counted colours as well.
- Design should include the words "Ontario Conference" and the Believe the Promise camporee logo.
- All entries must be submitted via the www.ontariopathfinders.ca website with the Pathfinder's name, church and club, investiture level, complete home mailing address, e-mail address, and home phone number.
- All submissions will become the intellectual/literal property of the Ontario Conference. The Ontario Conference has the right to reproduce or modify the design in any media and in whatever quantity as deemed necessary.

Prizes:

- The winner will receive \$100 and a trophy.
- The winner will be notified via e-mail. Announcement will be posted regarding the winning design on the www.ontariopathfinders.ca website.

General Rules:

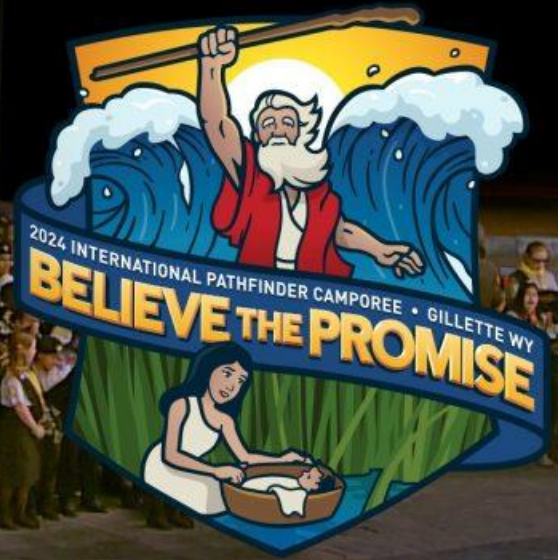
- Design should be made in vector format.
- A maximum of 5 colours shall be allowed. Do not count the colour of the metal pin material as it will appear at the edge of the design. If black and white are used, they are counted colours as well.

Tips on Preparing for a Visa Interview

1. Pray for God's guidance.
2. Follow US Consular instructions exactly, including evidence of travel ticket, funds for trip, and intention to return to your country. Learn more [here](#).
3. Print and include the [Camporee Introduction Letter](#). A letter of invitation is NOT required and will not be given as this is an open event.
4. Add a letter on church letterhead from your church or regional youth director, verifying you are an active participant, of good character, in the local Adventist church.
5. Print the [Camporee Week Schedule](#) and show if asked for details about activities.

MASTER GUIDE INVESTITURE

Sabbath morning investiture applications will be accepted through August 3, 2024. Only Master Guides will be invested at the Camporee. **All investiture applications received prior to June 16, 2024 will receive the commemorative pin and certificate at no cost.**

All applications received from June 16 through July 23, 2024 will need to pay \$10.00 for their certificate & pin at the AdventSource booth.

All investiture applications received after July 23, 2024 will still be eligible for Investiture while at the Camporee, however, we will only provide a pin and certificate if you request them at the AdventSource booth. The cost will be \$12.00.

A certificate and commemorative pin will still be available to you, however. They will be mailed to you after the Camporee is over.

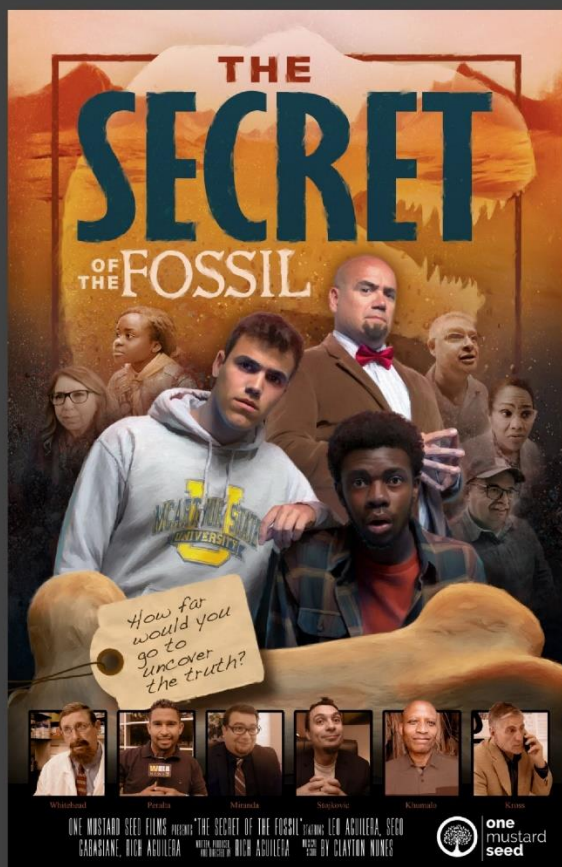
